

Guidance to users and risk assessment of Aston Road Car Park

Area A surfaced car park with parking for 55 cars. Access is from Aston Road between the A415 and the primary school. The car park does not have marked bays and is fenced on all sides. There is pedestrian access to the school and vehicular access to the Parish Council sports field and pavilion.

Hazards identified and their risk

- (1) [medium] Harm caused by vehicle collision with pedestrian
- (2) [medium] Harm caused by vehicle collision with vehicle
- (3) [low] Vehicle collision on entering or exiting the site
- (4) [low] Cuts from any broken glass around the re-cycle facility

Mitigations in place by the council

- (1) Separate pedestrian access maintained between car park and school
- (1) Internal visibility inside the car park is kept unrestricted, entrance is higher than car park
- (1) Safety zone marked indicating no parking to ensure access and visibility to sports field road
- (2) The size of the car park is such that a vehicle to vehicle collision would have to be low speed
- (3) The hedge is trimmed to aid visibility
- (4) The District Council regularly empty the bins to avoid overflow of glass

Mitigations not yet in place by the council

Guidance to users

- (1) Casual users of the car park should try and avoid the start and end of the school day as the car park is very busy
- (4) Users should be aware of the risk of broken glass and any found should be reported to WODC on 01993 861025
