Area A flat grassed area between Standlake road and the A415 commonly known as Glebelands. The grass is laid out to football pitches and cricket pitch in the summer. There is a pavilion, cricket nets and goal posts which are the responsibility of a local sports club. The area is fenced with regular gates for access.

Hazards identified and their risk

- (1) [medium] Children impacting with vehicles when exiting from cars parked on the carriageway of Standlake road
- (2) [low] Head or eye injury from impact with low branches
- (3) [low] Lack of access for emergency services
- (4) [low] Harm from tripping on uneven ground

Mitigations in place by the council

- (1) A car park with access to the site is provided by the council
- (1) The southern gate to Standlake road is locked shut
- (2) Trees are regularly inspected for damage and risk to users
- (4) Grass is managed and regularly cut to improve visibility

Mitigations not yet in place by the council

Guidance to users

- (1) Users should use the provided car park off Aston Road
- (1) Users are reminded of the advice from the Police and Oxfordshire CC Highways to not park in this location and use the car park provided
- (3) Users should avoid blocking the access
